THE JOHN SPECK MEMORIAL LIBRARY

Before getting to serious business, here are first some reminders. The Library is available to all members any time Zero's Cobey hardware store is open, six days a week. There are 2700 books and countless magazines related to the outdoors, available for your perusal and many for loan.

Next the serious business, beginning with a definition. Webster defines **TO EMBEZZLE** as: To appropriate fraudulently to one's own use, as property entrusted to one's care. According to the just completed Library Catalog, **159** items were taken from the shelves, not checked out in the Sign-out Register and not returned within six months; in other words: **embezzled**. Included are 64 climbing guides and 14 videos. Not included are items properly checked out, although some are overdue.

The *159* items were appropriated fraudulently by members. The Library belongs, indirectly, to the club. Even though you are a member, the item you did not return does not belong to you alone, it belongs to all members and you are depriving the others of their use: your climbing partners, your friends!

A later CMC Bulletin will include a listing of the *159* items missing. Please check the list. You may have forgotten that you borrowed items that you did not return. Go over the list carefully. Did you climb in the area of which a guide book is missing? If you remember and you lost the item, come forward. We understand; perhaps the item can be replaced; but in order not to be an embezzler, come forward.

If you find any of the items in your possession, return them, no questions asked. Many missing items are irreplaceable. Leave them in the Library next to the Sign-out Register, or send them to the Librarian in the mail. Or bring them to a meeting. Only this: **don't be an embezzler**.
